

**MISSION TRAILS ROP SPECIAL EDUCATION ASSESSMENT MODEL
HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL**

Assessment Orientation

- Takes place before assessment
- Full explanation of purpose of each assessment
- Establishes supportive environment for student
- Ensures the student has a satisfactory understanding of assessment process

Assessment Intake Interview (15 minutes)

- Briefly screen for information about career interests, educational background, work history/related experiences, health conditions, barriers/constraints, motivation and other individual needs.
- Utilizes vocational intake checklist & Structured Vocational Interview Sheet

Interest Assessment (1 hour)

- According to student's abilities, one of the following surveys will be administered: Self Directed Search (English and Spanish), CHOICES (English, Spanish) and or Reading-Free Vocational Interest Inventory.
- This portion assists the student in clarifying career interests and in gathering related information.

Tour of ROP Center (30 minutes)

- Meet the teachers and get an overview of the different classes offered

Vocational Personality Type Assessment (1 hour)

- Computerized Vocational Implications of Personality will give the student information about individual work preferences, values and work styles
- According to the ability and comprehension of the student, this assessment may or may not be administered.

Skills/Self-awareness Assessment/Activities (1 hour)

- Learning Styles Assessment
- Skills/Strengths Assessment, Skills/Weaknesses Assessment
- Obstacles/Barriers/Hurdles to Achievement of Education Goals Assessment

Student/Teacher Follow-up (1 hour)

- Follow-up with the student, once enrolled, for progress during the semester (Vocational classes)
- Follow-up with the student's teachers for progress

Structured Exit Interview (15 minutes)

- Clarification and discussion of information provided by the student
- Review of assessment results and interface these results with potential career goals
- Provides closure to the assessment sessions

Construct Report - (1 hour)

- Write a summary, make recommendations, compile and interpret assessment results.
- Identify limitations and challenges for the student if needed

Student Conference (15 minutes)

- Review completed report with student and have him or her approve by a signature.
